
Waivers & Forms



ALL activities that pose any assumed risk require a completed waiver form. The waiver for “Arts-Insane” is included in the registration process (whether you register online or in person). If you are unable to grant the permissions requested please let us know immediately.

When you registered you provided emergency contact and medical information. If anything has changed since registration, please let us know.

Drop-off/Pick-up



Camp runs from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm from August 13-15 at the Red Brick Arts Centre, 4818 7 Avenue. Doors open about 15 minutes before camp start time. Please come to the main entrance doors at the front of the building.

For your child’s safety, please ensure that you sign them in and out each day - always inform the camp leaders if someone else will be picking up your child and write it on the sign-in sheet. If your child will travel to and from camp on their own, please let us know at alicjab@edson.ca providing your permission for them to do so, so we can allow them to sign in and out.



Late Pick-up

Please respect camp times when dropping off and picking up kids. We can not provide before and after camp care - the building will be locked at 4:00 pm.

Lunches & Snacks - please note: we are a *nut-free* camp



Bring a lunch as well as nutritious snacks for morning and afternoon (we encourage litterless lunches) plus a reusable water bottle labelled with your child’s name. Participants will have access to a microwave given they have a microwave safe container. If your child has a serious allergy, please ensure that we have that information so we can inform other families and consider this in our planning of any edible treats.

What your child needs to bring each day:



This camp will include some outdoor activities, please send sunscreen, insect repellent (if your family uses these items), and a hat. To reduce waste, we ask to bring your own hand towel (it may get paint on it) in order to wipe hands during projects.



Your child may be getting “down and dirty” with art supplies. Washable materials are used whenever possible, but some may adhere to clothing. Children will be most comfortable in clothes that allow for active movement and mess. Separate outdoor shoes for lunch hour and outdoor activities may be needed if we encounter wet weather. Clearly mark your child’s name on belongings. Please bring a bathing suit and towel, as we may visit the spray park if the weather allows it!
