Sealed Tenders clearly marked “**BENCH CREEK BANK STABILIZATION AND RELATED WORKS PROJECT**” will be received by the undersigned at the Edson Civic Building (605-50th Street, Edson) up to and no later than **3:00 p.m. (local time), Tuesday, August 7, 2018.**

The project consists of the following and related tasks but not limited to:

- **Water Diversion & Seepage Control (Incidental Work),**
- **Subgrade Preparation and Levelling Course,**
- **Common Excavation,**
- **Vegetated Shoreline Defense System – SCOURLOK SDS or Approved Equivalent,**
- **Granular Base Course,**
- **Native and Imported Backfill,**
- **Permanent Erosion Protection - ARMORMAX@75 or Approved Equivalent**

Tender Documents may be obtained at the Town Office, Civic Center, 605-50th Street upon a non-refundable payment of \$100.00 in cash or certified cheque made payable to the Town of Edson. Tender Documents may also be viewed and/or downloaded from the Edmonton Construction Association web-site (COOLNet) and the Alberta Purchasing Connections web-sites. Bidders are required to communicate their address details in writing (via e-mail or fax) to the undersigned to ensure that addendums to bidding documents, if any were to be issued, are received.

Tender **must be** accompanied by all documents listed in the bid document and under the ‘Tender Form Supplement’, including Bid Bond, Consent of Surety, and a Copy of Current Safety Certificate (COR) or Temporary Letter of Certification, as called for in the tender document.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all tenders and the lowest tender may not necessarily be accepted. The Owner may decide, at its sole discretion, that no bid submitted will be accepted and no Contract will be awarded pursuant to this Bid process. In that event, all Bidders will be notified and the Owner will have no liability to any Bidder. If the Owner decides to accept a Bid and award a Contract, the selection of the successful Bidder will be based on a number of criteria which will include, but is not limited to, the price, delivery date, and qualification of the Bidder. Receipt of an Invitation to Bid and evaluation by the Owner of a bid does not imply that the Bidder is qualified. The Owner reserves the right to waive informalities rejecting any or all Bids, or to accepting the Bid deemed most favorable in the interest of the Owner.
