BYLAW NO. 1893

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF EDSON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, BEING CHAPTER M-26.1 OF THE STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1994 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, TO AMEND THE TOWN OF EDSON MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN BYLAW NO. 1864.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to amend the Town of Edson Municipal Development Plan;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Edson duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- That Municipal Development Plan Bylaw No. 1864 being the Town of Edson Municipal Development Plan is hereby amended.
- 2. That Figure 4.1, Future Predominant Land Use Map, being part of the Municipal Development Plan of the Town of Edson, be amended by the addition of the land use designation RCR (Recreational/Residential Low Density Mix-Unserviced) and by redesignating all of SW-18-53-17-W5M from CL (Commercial/Light Industrial Mix) and R1 (Residential Low Density—Unserviced) to RCR (Recreational/Residential Low Density Mix-Unserviced), as shown on attached "Schedule A"; and
- 3. That this Bylaw shall have force and take effect from the final reading thereof.

READ a first time this 1st day of February A.D. 2000.

READ a second time this 7th day of March A.D. 2000.

READ a third time and finally passed this 7th day of March A.D. 2000.
