## **Water Tower Demolition**

**Edson, Alberta, April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2015** – After discussions with the contractor the timing for the Water Tower Demolition has been set for approximately 10:30am on Wednesday April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2015.

For those wishing to witness the event please note that you do so at your own risk and there is a possibility of dust and debris being released as the Tower comes down. The spectator viewing area is the parking lot at Talisman Place. We ask that you please respect the barriers set up and stay within the designated safety areas.

Starting at 9am some streets in the area will be closed to the public. 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be closed from 49<sup>th</sup> to 50<sup>th</sup> Street and 49<sup>th</sup> and 50<sup>th</sup> Street will also be closed from 11<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The bus lanes at Holy Redeemer will also be closed off during the demolition.

The Town of Edson recognizes the historical value of the Edson Water Tower and is working closely with the Edson and District Historical Society on preserving this moment in Edson's history.
