COVID-19 Regulations

COVID 19 Day Camp Guidelines including frequent handwashing will be followed. For more information on these check out alberta.ca/BizConnect.

By registering your child, you are acknowledging that your child:

1. Has not been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID 19 in the last 10 days.
2. Left the country in the last 14 days.
3. Experienced any of the symptoms in the last 10 days:
 - Cough
 - shortness of breath
 - Fever
 - runny nose
 - sore throat

Please perform a temperature check of your child before they attend. The Alberta Daily Health Checklist will also be done at the time of drop off.

Drop-off/Pick-up

Camp runs from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm at the Kinsmen Shack in Kinsmen Park near the spray park. Doors open about 15 minutes before camp start time. The main entrance doors are on the west side of the building.

For your child's safety, please ensure that you sign them in and out each day - always inform the camp leaders if someone else will be picking up your child and write it on the sign-in sheet. If your child will travel to and from camp on their own, please inform us at the contact information below.

Please respect camp times when dropping off and picking up kids. We cannot provide before and after camp care - the building will be locked at 4:00 pm.

Lunches & Snacks - please note: we are a *nut-free* camp

Bring a lunch as well as nutritious snacks for morning and afternoon (we encourage litterless lunches) plus a reusable water bottle labelled with your child's name. Participants will have access to a microwave given they have a microwave safe container. If your child has a serious allergy, please ensure that we have that information so we can inform other families and consider this in our planning of any edible treats.

What your child needs to bring each day:

This camp will include active, messy and outdoor activities. Children will be most comfortable in clothes that allow for active movement and are okay to get dirty. Separate outdoor shoes for outdoor activities may be needed if we encounter wet weather. Please send sunscreen, insect repellent and a hat. To reduce waste, we ask to bring your own hand towel (it may get paint on it) in order to wipe hands during projects. This towel will not be shared. Please bring a bathing suit and towel, as we may visit the spray park if the weather allows it.

Clearly mark your child's name on belongings.
