


Protective Services

Fire Department




- Our fire department does a great job. They are always out in the community volunteering. If anything I think they require more full time staff to handle their demands.


RCMP Services

- As a new person in our community the crime is very evident and they could use our support.



Family and Community Support Services




- More supports for our vulnerable population are needed, which may include more staff or other funding areas such as grants.

Parks




- Grass doesnt need to be cut constantly or flowers watered in the rain

 are not feasible for working parents


Edson & District Leisure Centre


Roads and Sidewalks/Snow Removal


