### **Employer Eligibility Requirements**

- The company must be incorporated, or registered by or under, an act of the legislature of a province, territory, or the Parliament of Canada
- Must have a place of Business in the Town of Edson
- Have a valid Town of Edson Business Licence (unless exempted)
- Not be in violation of any federal or provincial regulations
- Not have any Occupational Health and Safety complaints within the 24 months prior to applying and be in good standing
- Not have any health violations through Alberta Health Services within the 24 months prior to applying and be in good standing
- Be in good standing with Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC)
- ✤ Agree to work with the Town to advance newcomer success in Edson

### **Employer Information: Job Offer requirements**

- Continuous, paid work in your designated community
- ✤ Full-time work, defined as a minimum of 30 hours per week
- Employment for 12 months or more
- Wages and benefits that meet or exceed the lowest starting wage for your occupation across all industries in Alberta as set out on the <u>Alis website</u>
  - if your employer has obtained a positive Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA) for your occupation, wages and benefits must meet or exceed the requirements set out in your LMIA.

### Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- Is there a limit on the number of applications / job postings an employer can apply for?
  - Not to our knowledge
- Is a Labour Market Impact Assessment required?
  - ✤ No. You are allowed to wave the LMIA.
- \* Is the program open to candidates who are already in Canada?
  - Yes but those candidates must have valid temporary status in Canada.
- What happens if the job doesn't work out?
  - Employer must follow employment standards and regulations and also notify the Town, who will then notify AAIP
- \* Are Employers allowed to have immigration consultants represent them?
  - ✤ Yes
