## **Encroachment Agreement Information**

An Encroachment Agreement often is required when a structure such as a fence, shed, house, garage, etc. is constructed beyond your property line(s) or over an easement or right-of-way. Encroachments are usually discovered when a property is surveyed or sometimes when a Certificate of Compliance is requested.

An Encroachment Agreement is a formal acknowledgement by the Town to allow the structure to remain as is.

## How to obtain an Agreement for Structures Encroaching onto Town Lands

- If you have a structure (for example a fence, shed, house, garage, etc.), as shown on a recent Real Property Report, that encroaches over Town Lands (street, avenue, lane, road right of way, utility right of way, municipal reserve, etc.) an Encroachment Agreement is usually required or the structure(s) is/are required to be removed.
- 2. An application form (page 1 of this application) is required to be filled out in full.
- 3. You must obtain written acknowledgements from utility service providers indicating that they have no objections to allow the encroachment. Contact name and numbers are listed below:

- 4. Once you receive written acknowledgement of "no objection" to the encroaching structure(s), you can submit your completed application form, all written supporting documents (email responses are acceptable), an Real Property Report no older than 10 years showing the encroachment, and the non-refundable application fee of \$350.00 to the Development Authority for review and referral to Town departments.
- 5. If your application is approved, the Development Authority will provide you three copies of the Encroachment Agreement for you to review and for you and your witness to sign. Your witness must also sign an affidavit. You must return the Agreements to the Town once signed and pay a \$100.00 submission fee to the Town for the Land Titles Office.
- 6. The Town will then sign and seal the Agreements and return three copies to you with a Caveat. The Town must register the agreement on the Land Title within 30 days.
- 7. Once the agreement is registered on the Land Title, you will provide the Town with a copy of the land title showing the registration of the Agreement. Fees apply for LTO.
- 8. If your application is rejected, you will receive a letter advising when you must remove the encroaching structure(s). The application fee is non-refundable.

**NOTE**: The Town does not require agreements for structures that are encroaching over private lands.
