Welcome to Swimming Lessons

The Town of Edson is an affiliate of the Lifesaving Society of Alberta. All our instructors have completed the 30-hour Swim Instructor course, 40-hour National Lifeguard course as well as the 16-hour Standard First Aid course. Our priority is the safety of our guests. Please take a minute to read the below expectations while visiting for swimming lessons.

Information

- No pictures/videos of other swimmers or instructors are permitted.
- If swimmer is under 8 years of age a caregiver (aged 13+) must be in the pool area for the entire lesson
- Outdoor footwear is not permitted in change rooms or viewing area. Please place shoes on boot rack
- Caregivers of Preschoolers should be prepared to accompany shy/nervous swimmers into lessons until they are comfortable.
- Please report any relevant medical conditions to Instructor. Ex. Asthma, Diabetes, Epilepsy etc.
- In the event of an emergency follow Instructors directions.
- Swimmers are not permitted if they are ill. Ex. Cold, Flu, open wounds etc.
- Swimmers wait in the viewing area until the instructor calls their class.
- Children that are not in lessons stay in the viewing area. Please do not allow children to climb on bleachers or run on the pool deck.
- There is no food or glass allowed in the viewing area. Drink containers that will not break ARE allowed.
- Swimmers with long hair should have it tied back out of their face for the best success.
- 1-piece swimsuits are recommended for swimmer comfort.
- Goggles should be in working order, instructors cannot continuously fix goggles.
- Treat Instructors, fellow swimmers, and facility with respect.
- Swimmers that are not following instructions will be asked to sit on the edge of the pool.
- Swimmers that continue to be a safety concern will be sent to their caregivers.
- Report cards will be ready the day after the last lesson has occurred.
- If a guardian has any concerns, please speak to the instructor after the lesson.
