- Built in 1980 for a population of 5,671
- 2012 Proposed Expansion \$12 Million estimate (not approved)
- 2017 Edson and Area Community Services Strategic Plan
- 2020 Library Plan of Service
- 2020 Project Plan
 - 2020/2021 Feasibility Study
 - 2022 Schematic Design & Detail Design
 - 2022 Construction Documents

- 250+ Community members through the door every day on average.
- Edson Community is one of the top data users in the Yellowhead Library System.
- E-resources are used more than many contemporaries with larger populations.

REASONS FOR THE PROJECT

- Feedback from the Community (Plan of Service surveys)
 - Too loud
 - Too crowded
 - Not enough space for programming
 - Too small of a collection
 - Not enough space for community use (example tutors)
- Code Compliance
- Capacity we have outgrown the space
- Safety and Maintenance
