JOB DESCRIPTION Junior Lifeguard-Instructor

Position Duties:

- Instructs and lifeguards aquatic programs in a professional manner
- Competent and skilled in emergency response procedures and providing first aid.
- Reports any deficiencies or safety concerns to Aquatics Supervisor
- Assists with routine maintenance and daily cleanliness providing a clean and safe environment for all patrons
- Enforces pool rules and Alberta health regulations with patrons using the pool
- Make sound decisions regarding patron usage with safety as the main concern when issues arise
- Must actively participate in all "in-service" training.
- Maintain good public relations with the general public and staff.
- Actively participate in Formal Workplace Inspections in area of responsibility
- Review pertinent Hazard Identification, Assessment and Control worksheets on an annual basis as required by the Municipal Health and Safety Program
- Follow all Safe Work Practices and Procedures
- Immediately report any unsafe conditions, potential work hazards or incidents to Supervisor
- Perform other related duties as directed by supervisor.

Position Requirements:

- National Lifeguard Award (NL)
- Lifesaving Society Swim Instructor
- Standard First Aid or Aquatic Emergency Care
- WHMIS, is preferable
