BYLAW NO. 1922

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF EDSON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND TOWN OF EDSON BYLAW NO. 1879 FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE EDSON PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD.

WHEREAS the Town of Edson deems it desirable and expedient to amend the the Town of Edson Public Library Board Bylaw No. 1879;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Edson, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

PURPOSE

1. That Bylaw No. 1879, Part II, Section 2 be amended by deleting Section 2 and replacing with:
  2. The Board shall consist of no fewer than five (5) and not more than ten (10) voting members who shall be appointed by resolution of Council. The said Board members shall consist of:
    - (a) One (1) member of Council; and
    - (b) Up to nine (9) members from the public at large; of which no more than three (3) members may be residents of Yellowhead County.
2. That Bylaw No. 1879, Part III, Section 1 be amended by deleting Section 1 and replacing with:
  5. The Board shall meet no less than once every four months, and shall endeavour to meet at least ten (10) times per calendar year, with the time and date to be determined by the Board on an annual basis. The time and date of these regular meetings can be altered by the Board when necessary.

EFFECTIVE DATE

3. That this Bylaw shall take effect on final reading thereof.
